Call the Meeting to Order:

Commissioner Karsky called the meeting to order. Traci Smith handed out the Agenda for today's meeting, an updated report of the Public Defender's Office financials and a copy of the Advisory Board Meeting minutes from the meeting held on 9/10/2019.

- (1) Minutes were approved from the 5/15/2018 meeting.
- (2) Commissioner Karsky moved to the second Item on the agenda which was the Financial Report. Traci gave an overview of where the department is at this time. No Action is required.
- (3) Commissioner Karsky went on to Item number three on the agenda which was a review of the Public Defender proposed Annual Report. Betsy Doyle spoke about the intern program which was included in the report.
