The pathway students along with two new attorney hires will be starting August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
- (5) New Business: Ryan White announced he is going to step down from his position on the Advisory Board to allow someone else the opportunity to serve on the Board. Discussion was had on procedure to appoint a new person. Ryan White stated he would be happy to remain on the Board until a new replacement is found. Commissioner Heisey spoke about a conference he attended and information he learned from a vendor on technology available that other states and counties are putting into place to assist with interpreting services, and how it may help with the Interpreting costs. Commissioner Heisey said he would find the vendors' information and share that with Traci Smith.
