On 4/12/23 at 4:30 p.m., the Minnehaha County Sheriff's Office was dispatched to the 1200 block of East Old Hickory Street for a structure fire. Upon arrival, the deck and back of the house were on fire. It was determined the residents of the house were not home, but two dogs were inside an attached garage. Multiple fire departments responded and were able to contain and extinguish the fire. The dogs were safely rescued from the garage and will be brought to the veterinary for evaluation. One firefighter was evaluated on scene for heat exposure. The origin and cause of the fire is still under investigation by the Minnehaha County Sheriff's Office.

The Minnehaha County Sheriff's Office was assisted by Minnehaha County Emergency Management, Renner Fire Rescue, Sioux Falls Fire Rescue, Brandon Fire Rescue, Baltic Fire Rescue and MedStar Ambulance.
